




# **CONFERENCE VENUE**

The Beurs van Berlage has been an international hotspot with charm since 1903. The former stock exchange and trade centre is a building of grandeur but also 'the place to be' in the soul of Amsterdam.

We chose this meaningful space as it's a typical "golden age" spot in the heart of the city. Our approach is to write new narratives and a symbolic way of reclaiming space.









# The gala dinner and business awards will be held at the Scheepvaartmuseum (The National Maritime museum) in Amsterdam, in their spectacular indoor courtyard – which has an elaborate glass ceiling with a design reminiscent of a compass rose – that lights up like a starry sky.

This was also a mindfully selected venue – one that is vocally committed to combating (institutional) racism – constantly addressing Netherlands' colonial past and history of slavery. This is portrayed not only through their exhibitions, their internal and external partners and educational programmes but also ensuring their workforce reflects Dutch society.


## TAXI/UBER

The travel time from Amsterdam Airport Schiphol to the Beurs Van Berlage takes 39 minutes (23.3 KM) in peak traffic time

## **PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

Very convenient and frequent connection from Amsterdam Airport Schiphol to Amsterdam Central Station by train.

From Amsterdam Central Train station to the conference venue, it is a 5 min walk.








# TRAVELLING TO THE VENUES

The travel time from Beurs Van Berlage to The National Maritime Museum (Gala dinner & business awards location) takes 26 minutes (7 KM) in peak traffic time.

Alternatively, if you decide to explore by foot, it is a (lovely) 20 minute walk.














## INTERNATIONAL RAIL TRAVEL

Eurostar offers direct trains from London, UK to Amsterdam, Netherlands. The duration of the journey is 4 hours and departs from London St. Pancras International Station and arrives at Amsterdam Centraal Station.

Amsterdam Centraal Station is 5 minutes walk from to the conference venue, Beurs van Berlage.







## INTERNATIONAL RAIL TRAVEL

<u>International Delegates from Europe</u> can book their trains through the <u>Eurostar Website</u> or through <u>NS international</u>, a company that helps book trains from large public transportation companies such as:

Furthermore, delegates can travel from within the Netherlands and explore the country via trains and other forms of transportation through the website <u>9292 NL</u>. You can also download the app 9292 NL for Android and iPhone.

Delegates can also use <u>OV-Chipkaart</u> which is a contactless card that is similar to the Oyster Card used in London's transportation system and can be topped up at an array of different locations across The Netherlands.

This allow delegates and attendees to make unlimited use of the sightseeing boats that cruise through the historic canal district. This tour is valid for 24 hours and attendees can use this at any time of day and is the best way to explore the city's canals and get around town easily!
